## GATHERING

Toddlers / Younger kids Get the children to hold out their hands. As you share the following words. 'Thank you God for making a wonderful world. You have made everything in it and you have made me. You are a good God who loves us all' Amen

If you have an inflatbale globe, you could pass this around as you say this prayer. Children can add things that God has in his hands

Thank you God for having the whole world in your hands. Thank you for making... (pass on the globe) **Older Kids / Teens** 

"In his hands are the depths of the Earth and the mountain peaks belong to him.

We thank you Lord for holding the whole world in your hands, from the smallest baby to the oldest person. From the mountain tops to the depths of the Ocean.

You are a God who is great and holds each and everone of us, we give you praise."

### WEEK 1: WHAT IS PRAYER?

### **PRAYER ACTIVITIES**

Toddlers / Younger kids Collect up some toy telephones they could be pretend or real. Encourage the small children to have a chat on them, they could call up their parents, or friends. What about if they called up God? What would they talk about? Prayer is a telephone conversation with God. We can use it to say Thank you, tell him we are sorry or talk about things that worry us.

Older Kids / Teens What social media platforms do you use to connect with your firends or family? Snap chat? Tik Tok? What kinds of things do you share with them? If you were to 'Snap' God what would the message be? If young people struggle verbalising this, you can use the templates on the next page

### All Ages


Head out on a prayer walk. What can you see that God has created? Stop at various points to look out at the creations that you have seen. You could make this an opportunity to share a prayer of thanks, or concern. *Risk Assessment: Go on the walk before hand, to check out the route, consider the weather, risks, hazards and ages.* 

### **QUESTIONS / PROMPTS**

Todlers / Younger Kids When can we pray to God? What kinds of things might we like to pray for or about? Who can give me an example of a thank you prayer? How do we feel when we think God isn't listening to us?

### Older Kids / Teens

How do we invite the Holy Spirit into our prayer lives? What role does the Holy Spirit play in prayer? Does technology support or prevent a good prayer life? explain Where can you get support with prayer?





#### **Prayer Stick Craft**

Sometimes I can be hard to pray as we don't know how to start our prayers.

You can make these one per young person or one for you church / youth group

Write starters or examples of things to pray for on the lolly sticks. Decorate the jars (or old tin cans) with stickers, paint or decorations.

### WEEK 2: HOW DID JESUS PRAY?

### **PRAYER ACTIVITIES**

**Toddlers / Younger kids** Have a go at the colouring page, take this home so that you can practice the words with your family.

You could cut on the cards and have the children sort them into the correct order.

### Older Kids / Teens

The Lord's Prayer starts with an acknowelgement of the greatness of God. 'Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed by your name' Its also a prayer of thankfulleness for what God has done and will do for us. Take time as a group to consider what you are thankful for, and presnet this in a creative way. It could be creating a piece of art work, or writting a poem or song. It may involve taking images or even through film. Spend time as a group or indiducal duing this. In your session you may wish to provide art materials for this happen. Or why not gift them a notepad, they can decorate to keep their prayers, and thankfullness in as they leave the session.

Make your own prayer braclet. You need beeds in different colours, thread these onto a cord or elastic. Each colour represents a different part of the prayer. See the helpful prompt sheet on the next page

### **QUESTIONS / PROMPTS**

Todlers / Younger Kids What does bread mean? Is it just the bread we eat? Explain words that they might not udnderstnad such as 'hallowed' 'temptation'. The language of this prayer can be challening for children to understand.

### Older Kids / Teens

What is special about how this prayer is organised? What elements does it contain? Why do you think that this was the prayer that Jesus taught them? How is this prayer stil relavant in our lives today? Which bits of the prayer do you think are tricky and why?


Share the Bible Reading And when you pray, do not be like the hypocrites, for they love to pray, standing in the synagogues and on the street corners to be seen by others. Truly, I tell you, they have received their reward in full. But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done secretly, will reward you. And when you pray, do not keep babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.

### **Key Points**

- 1. Prayer should be a true connection with God, not for showing off, but beacuse we want to connect with him.
- 2. Prayers can be simple, we don't need to make them complicated, or use big words to look or sound important. God wants us to be true.
- 3. Praying alone in and silence is good. Its about us having time with God. We don't need to always do it in public or at church.

How can we pray?

We can pray on our own, with others and using our own words. God wants to have a REAL converstaion with us. Listening is also important!

# GATHERING

#### Share the Bible Reading

John 14.8-14 Philip said, "Lord, show us the Father; that will be enough for us." Jesus answered: "Don't you know me, Philip, even after I have been among you such a long time? Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father'? Don't you believe I am in the Father, and the Father is in me? The words I say to you I do not speak on my own authority. Rather, the Father, living in me, is doing his work. Believe me when I say I am in the Father, and the Father is in me, or at least believe the evidence of the works themselves. I tell you that whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and

they will do even greater things than these because I am going to the Father. And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it.

This week the focus is a BIG question, that can be challenging to adults never mind young people. Believing in God hearing our prayers involves having belief nad faith. Something which young people and children you are working with may not have developed. Therefore this week there is a number for activities which promote them being active in prayer, and have an opportunity to eperience God hearing them.

### WEEK FOUR: DOES GOD HEAR PRAYERS?

### **PRAYER ACTIVITIES**

#### **Candle Prayers**

Play some music of your choice.
Place candles either at the front, or on a table, where the young people can see the flame.
Watch the flame flicker and take time for them to be quiet, focusing on the flame. During this time they just sit quietly, they can if they wish offer some silent prayers. When the song or music ends, safely put out the flames.

#### **Balloon Prayers**

Hand out some baloons, get the kids to write on a slip of of paper people or situations they would like to pray for. Put the paper in the balloons. Ask them to blow up their baloon, but not tie it, just hold it. On the count of three let the baloons go! They will all fly off. When they have landed. Pick up a new balloon from the floor. Get into small groups, take out the papers and use these to pray over these as a group.

#### **Paper Areoplanes**

Each person makes a paper areoplane. Write or draw what you would like to pray about on it. Explain that when we pray the prayers fly straight into God's ears. Write GOD on a large sheet of paper, teh children then throw the planes at GOD. As a sign of sending the prayers to him. Explain that even if we miss the target our prayers never do!

#### Prayer washing line

Set up a washing line, with string and some pegs. You can either use paper people cut outs or print your own for them to cut out. Children can decorate them to either represent themselves or someone else they want to pray for. They add them to washing line to remember them in their prayers. You can adapt this to pray about the environment using cut out animals or fish. Or about differnet coutnries by decorating them to represent differnet parts of the word or adding countries to the back of people.
